

Information About Pledging At First UU Church of San Antonio

Making a pledge of financial support is one of the steps necessary for membership of this church.

Our church operates on a fiscal year that begins on June 1st and ends on May 31st. We use the pledged amount to determine what our budget will be for the upcoming fiscal year. Any pledge made after May 31st is a post-canvas pledge which covers that period of time until the end of May.

In the Spring, during our annual pledge drive, you will be asked to make another pledge for the upcoming church year which starts in June.

We do not require any specific amount of pledge in order to join the church and we don't want finances to prevent anyone from joining. Each person or family may pledge what works for their current financial situation. If zero is the amount you are able to pledge, we will take it! If your financial situation changes and you want to raise, lower, or withdraw your pledge, you can do so at any time.

We don't dictate a schedule for when you make payments. Some people pay monthly, others quarterly, and others in one lump sum. As long as the pledge is paid in full by the end of May, you will be considered a member in good standing.

Payment of your pledge can be done in many ways. You can pay in cash or check placed in the offertory basket. If you do place cash in the offertory basket, please use the envelopes found in the pews so that you get credit for your payment. You can also bring or mail checks directly to the church office at First UU San Antonio, 7150 W. Interstate 10, San Antonio, TX 78213.

Finally, you can stop by the church office and fill out an authorization form which permits the church to automatically debit your account on a monthly basis.
