

First Unitarian Universalist Church of San Antonio Resolution to Become a Green Sanctuary Congregation approved May 20, 2012

Be it resolved that the members of the First Unitarian Universalist Church of San Antonio, Texas, having supported our Green Sanctuary Team in completing the twelve Action Plans as required under the Unitarian Universalist Association's Green Sanctuary Program, approve the submission of the Green Sanctuary Team's application for our accreditation as a Green Sanctuary congregation.

{Created in 1989, the Green Sanctuary program is a path for congregational study, reflection, and action in response to environmental challenges. It provides a structure for congregations to examine their current environmental impacts and move towards more sustainable practices grounded in Unitarian Universalism.}
